a. the <u>M</u> all	The student attempts to demonstrate appropriate use of conventions of the English language by capitalizing mall but doesn't recognize this as a general noun.	
b. <u>P</u> utt- <u>P</u> utt <u>G</u> olf	The student attempts to demonstrate appropriate use of conventions of the English language by capitalizing putt-putt golf but doesn't recognize this as a general noun.	
c. <u>W</u> ashington <u>P</u> ark (Correct)	The student demonstrates appropriate use of conventions of the English language by correctly identifying the proper noun and the capitalization needed for the sentence.
