

Response Option	Response Rationale	
a. The ocean was a large source of drinking water.	The student recognizes that the ocean is made up of water but does not understand that salt water is not drinkable.	
b. Farming was better in the ocean.	The student recognizes that crops need water but incorrectly concludes that ocean water can be used to water crops.	
c. The ocean was a good source of food and transportation. (Correct)	The student correctly observes that living near the ocean gave settlers access to food and transportation.
