

**Articulation Agreement Between
University of Kentucky
The Department of Family Sciences and The School of Human Environmental Sciences
and
Family and Consumer Sciences Education
Kentucky Department of Education
Office of Career and Technical Education**

The purpose of this agreement is to grant college credit to high school students for their coursework and training at the secondary level.

Students will be granted University of Kentucky credit if all the following criteria are met:

1. Receives a career major certificate in Consumer and Family Management.
2. Receives a letter grade of "B" or better in the career major courses and a 3.5 GPA overall.
3. Passes one of the following end-of-program assessments:
 - a. KOSSA – Consumer & Family Management
 - b. AAFCS Pre-PAC Assessment
 - i. Broad Field FCS
 - ii. Family and Community Services or
 - iii. Personal and Family Finance.
4. Instructors of the courses completed at the secondary level must hold a Master's Degree.
5. Submits the documentation, signed by school personnel, indicating all requirements have been met.
6. Re-evaluation of the agreement in (5) years.

Upon successful completion of the requirements above, students will receive University of Kentucky credit for the following courses:

- FAM 254- Lifecourse Human Development—3 hrs.
- DHN 101- Human Nutrition and Wellness—3 hrs.
