ADVISORY GROUP: Local Superintendents Advisory Council (LSAC)

MEETING DATE: January 29, 2019

Agenda Item: 704 KAR 3:303, Revision of Kentucky Academic Standards (Second Reading)

Presenters: Rhonda Sims/Krista Hall

Summary of Discussion:

Discussed the proposed amendment of the *Kentucky Academic Standards* to meet the requirements of Senate Bill 1 (2017) which calls for the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) to implement a process for reviewing and revising all academic standards and aligned assessments beginning in the 2017-18 school year. Once the revised social studies standards are adopted into regulation, 704 KAR 3:303 will contain only the standards for the arts, science, technology and career studies. Eventually all of those standards will be reviewed, revised and adopted into their own regulations. At that time, 704 KAR 3:303 will be repealed.

Action Taken: No questions were posed. The LSAC approved the proposed amendment of 704 KAR 3:303.

Follow-up Required: No follow-up was deemed necessary.

Agenda Item: 704 KAR 8:060, Revision of Academic Standard in Social Studies (Second Reading)

Presenters: Rhonda Sims, Krista Hall and Lauren Gallicchio

Summary of Discussion:

Discussed the proposed adoption of the *Kentucky Academic Standards for Social Studies* to meet the requirements of Senate Bill 1 (2017) which calls for the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) to implement a process for reviewing and revising all academic standards and aligned assessments beginning in the 2017-18 school year. Educators have taught the state's current social studies standards in Kentucky classrooms since 2006.

Presenters highlighted the additional supporting information and clarifications added to the standards document since the first reading. The additions address comments and concerns following the first reading. As additional content standards are revised, they will be incorporated by reference into their own regulation.

Action Taken: No questions were posed. The LSAC approved the adoption of the *Kentucky Academic Standards for Social Studies* as incorporated by reference in 704 KAR 8:060.

Follow-up Required: No follow-up was deemed necessary.

Agenda Item: **704 KAR 7:081**, Repeal of 704 KAR 7:080, Ride to the Center for the Arts Program Fund (Second Reading)

Summary of Discussion:

Discussed the consideration of repeal of 704 KAR 7:080, the Ride to the Center for the Arts Program Fund. Pursuant to legislative requirements to review all regulations for potential amendment or repeal, the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) identified 704 KAR 7:080 for repeal. Since the KDE never received funding for this program, the regulation is not needed.

Action Taken: No questions were posed. The LSAC approved the repeal of 704 KAR 7:080.

Follow-up Required: No follow-up was deemed necessary.

Agenda Item: **Amendment to 702 KAR 1:160**, School Health Services (Second Reading)

Presenters: Matthew Ross and Donna Duncan

Summary of Discussion:

This was the second reading of the Health Services Regulation amendment. The amendment adds a requirement that all districts adopt a “seizure action plan” policy. Seizure action plans are defined in statute are to be completed by a student’s doctor. The limited discussion centered on what districts could do to encourage a doctor to complete a plan. The amendment was approved by LSAC as written without any recommended changes.

Action Taken: LSAC approved the School Health Services Amendment.

Follow-up Required: No follow up was deemed necessary.

Agenda Item: **703 KAR 5:211**, Repeal of 703 KAR 5:200 Next Generation Learners (Action/Discussion)

Presenters: Rhonda Sims/Michael Hackworth

Summary of Discussion:

Rhonda Sims and Michael Hackworth discussed the need to repeal 703 KAR 5:200, Next Generation Learners since it is the old accountability regulation and a new one is now in place and has been used since the 2017-2018 school year.

Dr. Lewis added that the KBE may waive a second reading on this regulation and take action if they choose to do so since the regulation is outdated.

LSAC members did not have any questions or comments regarding the repeal of this regulation.

Action Taken:

LSAC members approved the repeal of 703 KAR 5:200, Next Generation Learners.
