ADVISORY GROUP: Local Superintendents Advisory Council (LSAC)

MEETING DATE: March 26, 2020

Agenda Item: Amendment to 701 KAR 8:020, Evaluation of Charter School Authorizers
(*Second Reading*)

Presenter: Kelly Foster and Whitney Crowe

Summary of Discussion: In addition to proposed amendments to 701 KAR 8:020, Section 3(4) revising the training requirements for charter school authorizers, which were part of the 1st reading of the regulation, the presenters discussed two additional substantive changes incorporated in the regulation's 2nd reading, including:

1. Removing from page 14, lines 7-8 the requirement for the Kentucky Department of Education to develop a charter application scoring rubric and
2. Deletion of Section 11 beginning on page 34 because the reporting requirements articulated therein go beyond what is required in KRS 160.1596(5) and are unnecessary in light of the limited charter school activity that has occurred in the state since 2017, which is when charter schools were first authorized under state law.

LSAC members did not raise any questions or concerns regarding this regulation.

Action Taken: LSAC approved the regulation.

Agenda Item: 780 KAR 1:011, Repeal of 780 KAR 1:010, Kentucky State Plan for Career and Technical Education (*Second Reading*)

Presenters: David Horseman, Tom Thompson and Leslie Slaughter

Summary of Discussion: Associate Commissioner Horseman explained the rationale for the repeal of this regulation. No questions were posed by members of the LSAC.

Action Taken: A motion for approval was made and seconded. All LSAC members voted unanimously to approve the second reading of 780 KAR 1:011, repeal of 780 KAR 1:010.

Agenda Item: 702 KAR 6:046, Repeal of 702 KAR 6:045, Personnel; School Nutrition Employee Qualifications (*Second Reading*)

Summary of Discussion: Lauren Moore explained the necessity of repealing the regulation to align state and federal training requirements for district nutrition employees.
