- Wear your mask



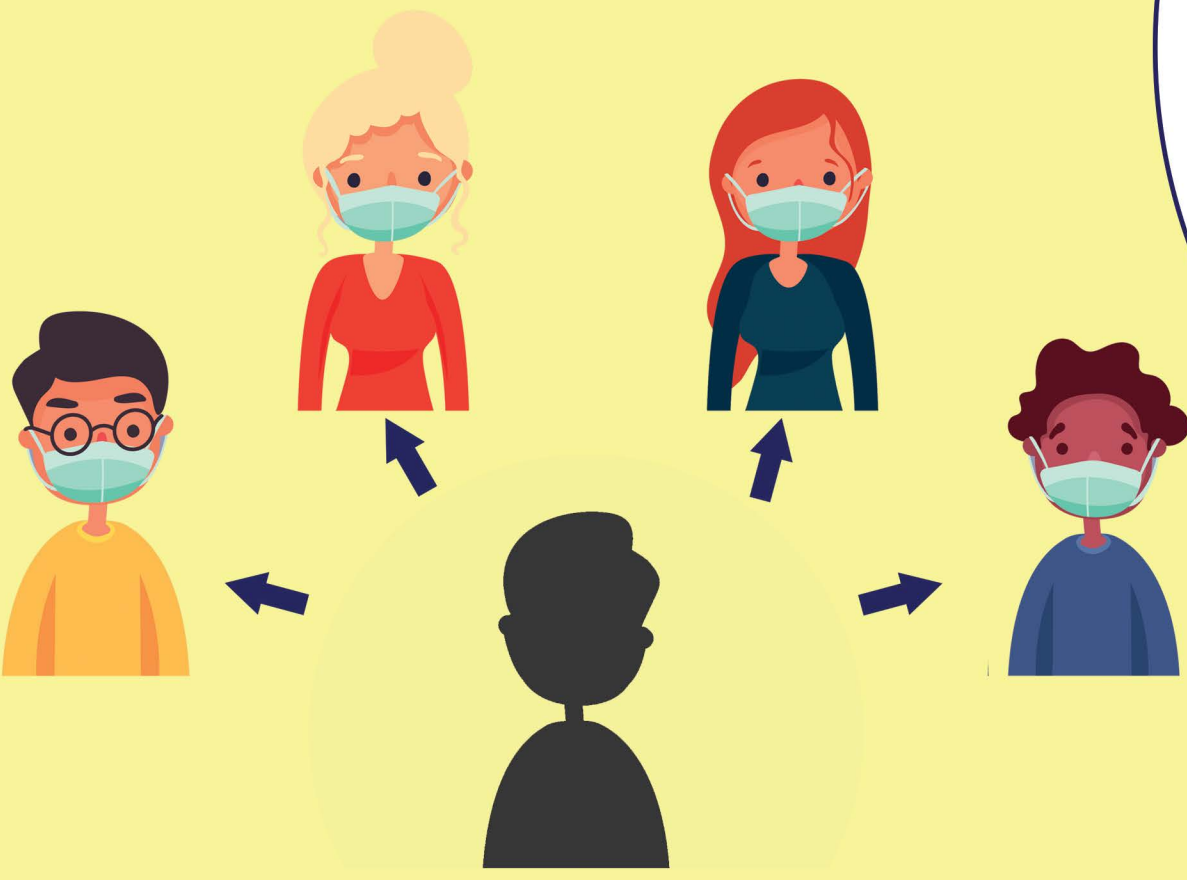
Cloth Face Coverings and School Health Policies

- Apply soap and scrub all surfaces of hands for 20 seconds

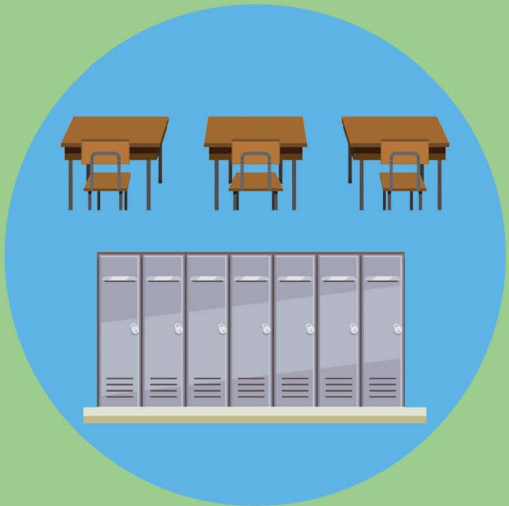


- Rinse and dry

Throughout the Day:



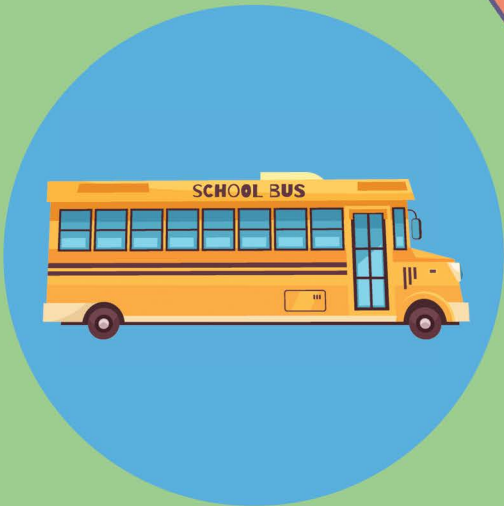
- Wash your hands
