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REGULATORY REVIEW WORK GROUP TO MEET APRIL 11

(FRANKFORT, Ky.) – The Commissioner’s Work Group for Regulatory Review, one of the groups involved with developing a new accountability system, will meet Tuesday, April 11 from 11:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. ET at the Kentucky Department of Education, 300 Sower Boulevard, State Board Room (#514) in Frankfort.

The Accountability Work Groups, as support to the Accountability Steering Committee, have designed various elements of Kentucky’s new school accountability system under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) – the new federal law governing public education.

The Regulatory Review Work Group will review recommendations from the other committees and determine if the proposals meet the statutory requirements of ESSA, identify any amendments to existing state statutes that may be required as a result of the proposals and determine any required state regulatory changes needed as a result of the recommendations.

The Kentucky Board of Education must approve any changes in the accountability system. The current timeline calls for the new system to be in place for the 2017-18 school year.
