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DYSLEXIA TASK FORCE TO MEET MAY 18

(FRANKFORT, Ky.) – The Dyslexia Task Force will meet Thursday, May 18, from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. ET at the Kentucky Department of Education, 300 Sower Blvd., 1st Floor Training Center, Room A, in Frankfort.

The Dyslexia Task Force is charged with developing recommendations on policy, personnel, and the instructional and fiscal resources needed to identify and support students with dyslexia. The group's work includes reviewing the most current national data and research on dyslexia; reviewing current policies and practices being implemented across Kentucky and other states for screening, identifying and instructing students with dyslexia; and examining and analyzing state level intervention data and current practices for students with dyslexia.

The task force is comprised of individuals who have experience and expertise in this area, including education shareholders from schools, local districts, postsecondary institutions, education cooperatives and advocacy groups.
