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ACCOUNTABILITY REGULATORY REVIEW COMMITTEE MEETS JULY 14

(FRANKFORT, Ky.) — The Commissioner's Work Group for Regulatory Review, one of the groups involved with developing a new accountability system, will meet Friday, July 14 from 9 a.m. – noon ET at the Kentucky Department of Education, 300 Sower Boulevard, State Board Room (#514) in Frankfort.

The Accountability Work Groups, as support to the Accountability Steering Committee, have designed various elements of Kentucky's new school accountability system under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) – the new federal law governing public education. The Regulatory Review Work Group reviews recommendations from the other committees and determines if the proposals meet the statutory requirements of ESSA, identifies any amendments to existing state statutes that may be required; and determines any state regulatory changes needed as a result of the proposals.

The Kentucky Board of Education must approve any changes in the accountability system.
