## **READ TO ACHIEVE ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETS NOVEMBER 16**

(FRANKFORT, Ky.) – The State Read to Achieve Advisory Council will meet Nov. 16 from 9 a.m.-1 p.m. in the State Board Room (#516), 300 Sower Boulevard in Frankfort.

In June, the Governor issued an Executive Order abolishing the Reading Diagnostic and Intervention Grant Steering Committee and creating the Read to Achieve Advisory Council. The purpose of the council is to implement and oversee the reading diagnostic and intervention fund created by KRS 158.792.

The RTA Council is comprised of 15 members, including the Secretary of the Education and Workforce Development Cabinet or designee who shall serve as a voting ex officio member; and four ex officio non-voting members designated by the Commissioner of Education, the Collaborative Center for Literacy Development, the Education Professional Standards Board and the School Curriculum, Assessment and Accountability Council.

The Governor appoints 10 voting members, who possess specific background in the areas of reading and literacy:
