SOCIAL STUDIES STANDARDS REVIEW AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE TO MEET

(Frankfort, KY) – The Social Studies Standards Review and Development Committee (RDC) will meet from 11 a.m. – 4 p.m. ET, Thursday, May 17 in the State Board Room (#514) at the Kentucky Department of Education, 300 Sower Blvd., in Frankfort.

Senate Bill 1 (2017) calls for the Kentucky Department of Education to implement a process for reviewing all academic standards and aligned assessments beginning in the 2017-18 school year. The current schedule calls for one or two content areas to be reviewed each year and every six years after that on a rotating basis.

The Social Studies Standards RDC is comprised of 13 members including elementary, middle and high school teachers, members from postsecondary education and representatives from the Kentucky business community.
