FINANCIAL LITERACY BUSINESS AND EDUCATION ADVISORY PANEL TO MEET

(FRANKFORT, Ky.) – The Financial Literacy Business and Education Advisory Panel (B&E) will meet Wednesday, November 28, from 10 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. ET in Room 516, at the Kentucky Department of Education, 300 Sower Boulevard, in Frankfort, KY.

KRS 158.6453 calls for the Kentucky Department of Education to implement a process for reviewing all academic standards beginning in the 2017-18 school year. The current schedule calls for one or two content areas to be reviewed each year and every six years after that on a rotating basis.

The Financial Literacy B&E Advisory Panel is comprised of nine members including five representatives from the Kentucky business community, three public high school teachers and one member from postsecondary education.
