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SCHOOL CURRICULUM, ASSESSMENT AND ACCOUNTABILITY COUNCIL TO MEET JAN. 15

(Frankfort, KY) – The School Curriculum, Assessment and Accountability Council (SCAAC) will meet at 9 a.m. (ET) on January 15, 2019 at the Kentucky Department of Education.

As mandated by KRS 158.6452, the SCAAC was abolished by Executive Order on June 16, 2017 and subsequently re-created to study, assess and audit Kentucky's system of setting academic standards, establishing curriculum, assessing learning, identifying academic competencies and deficiencies of individual students, holding schools accountable for student achievement, and assisting schools to improve their performance. SCAAC is comprised of 15 voting members, with the secretary of the Education and Workforce Development Cabinet, or his designee, and the commissioner of the Department of Education serving in ex-officio voting capacities along with 13 members appointed by the Governor.
