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FINANCIAL LITERACY REVISION AND WRITING COMMITTEE TO MEET

(FRANKFORT, KY) – The Financial Literacy Revision and Writing Committee (RWC) will meet 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. ET Friday, Jan. 18, at the Kentucky Department of Education in Frankfort, Kentucky.

House Bill 132 (2018), which took effect in July, calls for the Kentucky Board of Education to establish academic standards and a graduation requirement for financial literacy. The law, which will be in effect for students entering high school beginning in 2020, was designed to ensure that students are taught how to budget, save and invest.

The Financial Literacy RWC is comprised of six public high school teachers and two members from postsecondary education.
