Student must take and achieve ACT benchmarks as designated by the Council for Postsecondary Education (CPE). Student must take and score proficient on all required End-of-Course Assessments (EOCs). 	N/A: Credit hours do not apply.	 District diploma District retains ADA for the days the student is in attendance for three years. The KDE sends .5 ADA for year four directly to KHEAA for distribution for an "Early Graduation Certificate" to be directly awarded to the student's identified postsecondary institution. If enrolled for three full years, the student may receive a Kentucky Educational Excellence Scholarship (KEES) Early Graduate award equivalent to completing high school in four years.
