

Building a Culture of Learning Spring Online Study January 13 – April 17

This self-paced study allows educators across the state an opportunity to dig deeper into how Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) can help build a culture of learning in schools and districts. The goal of the study is to develop a common understanding of:

- what it means to be a teacher in an effective PLC.

The study will include:

- monthly assignments including articles, book excerpts, videos and other related media,
- time for reflection,
- action research as you apply learning to your practice, and
- opportunities to collaborate with other KY educators as we share successes and struggles with the goal of improving teaching and learning for students.

A Google Classroom format allows participants to work at their own pace as they read and interact with the community.
