STUDENTS 09.1222

Nonresident Students

The District shall allow nonresident students to enroll in the District pursuant to existing Admissions and Attendance Policy 09.12, Tuition Policy 09.124, and related procedures.

Upon allowing nonresident pupil enrollment, the policy shall allow nonresident children to be eligible to enroll in any public school located within the District. The policy shall not discriminate between nonresident pupils, but may recognize enrollment capacity, as determined by the District. The nonresident pupil policy and any subsequent changes adopted by the Board shall be filed with the Kentucky Department of Education no later than thirty (30) days following their adoption.¹

DEFINITION

Nonresident students are those students who reside with their legal parents/guardians outside the boundaries of the District. Residency cannot be established through living with a relative or friend within the District.

CRITERIA FOR ENROLLMENT

Nonresident students who wish to enroll in the District's schools may be granted permission to do so under the following provisions:

- 1. The student completes an "Application for Admission" that includes a contract outlining criteria for initial and continuing enrollment status;
- 2. The student provides an current immunization record for the school file;
- 3. The student and his/her parent/guardian is responsible for transportation to and from school;
- 4. Payment, by the end of the first nine-week grading period, of an amount equivalent to the ADA amount;
- 5. The District in which the student resides agrees to pay for all costs of any special services necessary for the student;
- 6. The student maintains a 2.0 G.P.A. in core academic classes;
- 7. Presentation of a positive recommendation from the last or previous school districts the student attended;
- 8. The student has made acceptable progress toward completion of school in the prescribed thirteen (13) years; nonresident students who have been retained more than one (1) time shall not be considered for enrollment;
- 9. The student has a behavioral history that is free of ongoing, chronic, and/or serious disciplinary problems;
- 10. The student has achieved and maintained an attendance record that is consistent with the current attendance policy of the District. Exceptions may be made by the Superintendent in certain circumstances;

CRITERIA FOR ENROLLMENT (CONTINUED)

- 11. The student has not been expelled from another school immediately prior to application for admission; and
- 12. Enrollment of nonresident students will not cause the district of attendance to exceed state class size maximums.

Upon recommendation by school officials, the Superintendent shall approve all nonresident student applications for initial and continued enrollment.
