CntyNo	A unique number or alphanumeric code assigned to the name of the county, parish, borough, or comparable unit (within a state) in which an address is located.	XXX 3 digit number (e.g. 301)
CnthyName	The name of the county, parish, borough, or comparable unit (within a state) in which an address is located.	text
Dist_Number	A unique number or alphanumeric code assigned to a local education agency by a school system, a state, or other agency or entity.	3 digit number, (e.g. 170) text
Dist_Name	The name of a non-person entity such as an organization, institution, agency or business.	text
Sch_Number	A unique number or alphanumeric code assigned to an institution by a school, school system, a state, or other agency or entity.	3 digit number (e.g. 170)
Sch_Name	The full legally accepted name of the institution.	text
Sch_Cd	The district and school identifier assigned to a school by the state education agency	Code Number assigned by KDE to identify the school building site. Schools are assigned a three (3) character District Number followed by a three (3) character School Number.

Test Name	This is the broad category that the assessment belongs to. For example, this field will have values like EPAS (Explore, Plan, and ACT).	The name of the assessment
Test Description	This is the description for particular domains and subjects that are within the main assessments.	The description of the assessment
Test Date	The year, month and day on which an assessment administration began.	Mm/dd/yyyy
Test Score	A meaningful raw score or statistical expression of the performance of a person on an administration of an assessment	The scale score of the assessment
