Changes to Reporting Components on the 2022-2023 Kentucky School Report Card

Each year Kentucky publishes a School Report Card to highlight key education metrics. An overview of the changes in the 2022-2023 School Report Card (SRC) are provided by Key Topic Area (domain) below.

Accountability:

Kentucky's Accountability System (KRS 158.6455) was fully implemented during the 2022-2023 school year. This was the first year in which Status and Change impact accountability. Other changes in this area include:

- The colored dials for Overall Performance Rating on the state indicators include Status (current year performance) and Change (difference between current year and prior year Status). Overall performance ratings are reported with five color levels, blue (highest), green, yellow, orange, and red (lowest).
- The Indicator Performance Ratings are displayed on color coded dials for each of the state indicators. These Indicator Ratings are based on the combination of Status and Change Levels.
- Each indicator is reported with five Status Levels (Very High, High, Medium, Low and Very Low) and five Change Levels (Increased Significantly, Increased, Maintained, Declined and Declined Significantly). Change Levels are also represented on the School Report Card with directional arrows.

Overview:

- Students Enrollment: Student Membership: The 2022-2023 counts are as verified through the traditional Superintendents Annual Attendance Report (SAAR) process.
- Students Attendance: Attendance Rate and Adjusted Average Daily Attendance (AADA) and Chronic Absenteeism data are once again included on the SRC.
- Faculty Profile Inexperienced Teachers by high and low-poverty schools is available at the district level in addition to the state level.

Academic Performance: No changes for 2023 reporting.

Educational Opportunity:

• Opportunity to Learn Survey is no longer administered; no data is available.

Transition to Adult Life: No changes for 2023 reporting.

School Safety: No changes for 2023 reporting.

Financial Transparency:

Financial data are reported once audited financials are available in the spring following the initial School Report Card release. The 2021-2022 reporting was completed May 2023. Reporting for 2022-2023 will be in May 2024.
