Home Visit 1: Enter date of first home visit

Home Visit 2: Enter date of second home visit

Note: Do not fill out the Preschool Tab for children receiving KSI/RTI intervention if they are not income eligible. This tab is only for eligible children. Also, do not fill out this tab for children who receive special education only services (service type "N"). These children are not receiving special education services in the classroom. You may fill out this tab for Head Start children served through the school district or in a school building and mark the Preschool Type as "Head Start". If the Head Start box is chosen in the preschool type, do not mark the boxes labeled Disabled State Fund, State Funded At Risk or the Head Start Enhanced box.
