

Custom Report: QA Homeless – The purpose of this report is to assist school and district personnel with verifying homeless student data based on data entered in Program Participation | Homeless. A student may appear multiple times but only once per enrollment per school. **This report is intended for internal use only, these reports contain sensitive data and must be handled appropriately.**

Selection Criteria: Use the Campus toolbar to select the year, school, calendar to use for the report. To obtain multiple schools or calendars, choose Select All. Selecting All Years is not allowed. Choose *Detail* option to obtain student level data. Choose *Aggregate* option for an overview of homeless data by race, gender, and student groups. Check the *Individual Aggregates* option to generate an aggregate report for each school in the district. Choose the *Create School Report Card* option to obtain a table of data to assist in verification of the homeless data on the School Report Card.

Report Sample(s):

The *Detail* report will be generated in Excel format. Each row provides data for a single enrollment for a student identified as homeless. The *Academic Year* indicates the end year of the school year being reported. The data output includes student demographics, primary nighttime residence, unaccompanied youth status and inclusion in other student groups. Output of 1 is True; output of 0 is False. The *Economically Disadvantaged* column will highlight records in which the students FRAM eligibility record indicates Reduced or Full Lunch. This is a data quality issue to be addressed. Enrollment End Date can be filtered to blank to obtain homeless students currently enrolled, excluding those who have withdrawn within the academic year. The report outputs student count and calculates a percentage to total homeless by grade level and demographic group, primary nighttime residence, unaccompanied youth status and by student groups.

Suggested report uses:

- Validate homeless records to ensure accuracy for school report card and other federal and state reporting.
 - Work with the Homeless Coordinator to ensure the correct students are reported including withdrawn students.
- Once the Homeless Coordinator evaluates a student as homeless, the student should remain homeless for the remainder of the academic year regardless of any changes in the student’s primary nighttime status.
 - Filter the detail report on the *Economically Disadvantaged* column to ensure that all homeless students are indicated as eligible for Free lunch. The field is highlighted if the eligibility status is Reduced or Full Price during the date range of the student’s homeless record. District Homeless Coordinators should collaborate with District Food Service Coordinators to ensure student’s FRAM eligibility record in Infinite Campus and Point of Sale (POS) record indicate Free lunch.
- Share aggregated PDF with district and school leadership for awareness and additional quality assurance.
- Utilize School Report Card output to verify and validate publicly reported data on the annual School Report Card.
