Dropout Data is due Nov. 1

This is a reminder to districts that dropout data is due by Nov. 1. Dropout data is extracted from Infinite Campus each year and is lagged by one year, so the prior school year is what will be reported. Schools are accountable for students for the full school year, including summer school. For more information contact the KDE Assessments mailbox.

Automated External Defibrillator Reporting

In accordance with KRS 158.162, Kentucky school districts are required to submit an annual report to the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) by November 1 that includes the following information.

- The number and location of each portable automated external defibrillator (AED) in every school building.
- 2. The name, school, and training date of each school district employee and interscholastic athletic coach in the district trained in the use of a portable automated external defibrillator.
- 3. The progress made towards having a portable automated external defibrillator at all school-sanctioned athletic practices and competitions.

Each district submitted AED counts via Infinite Campus, prior to October 1, with 100 percent compliance. A Survey Monkey <u>questionnaire</u> has been created for district completion to address its continued progress of increasing additional AEDS at sports-related events. Districts are reminded to reply to all questions prior to submission. Based on the new 2024 legislation in this area, a listing of all AED trained individuals in each building, including ALL coaches at the elementary, middle and high schools, must be provided. For the first year of reporting, only individuals trained from June 1 – October 1, 2024, will be included in this reporting. Any staff trained after this date will be included on next year's report.

Civil Rights Data Collection (CRDC) - Prepare now for 2023-2024

The next CRDC collection will be for the 2023-2024 school year and is tentatively scheduled to open on December 9, 2024, and close on March 7, 2025. KDE will continue to assist by prepopulating data that is available in state systems. Districts must enter the data not preloaded by KDE and must validate all data prior to submission. The timeline and helpful resources can be found on the KY CRDC webpage and the CRDC Resource Center webpage.

The Office of Civil Rights (OCR) sent out an email on October 17, 2024, to each superintendent and the two alternate contacts they had listed from the previous Civil Rights Collection. OCR is asking LEAs to reply to the email, to verify contact information, by October 31st to ensure they have accurate information prior to the launch. Because there is a short window of time, OCR will not be doing a registration as they have conducted in prior years.

Please note, it is important for districts to update Civil Rights Data Collection (CRDC) contacts each year. These individuals will receive communications from KDE regarding updates, reporting timelines and questions. To add or update the CRDC school or district contacts, please contact your district Web Apps Admin Point of Contact (WAAPOC). WAAPOCs are listed in the <u>District and School Directory</u>. WAAPOCs can update CRDC contacts in the Person Role Manager system.

Civil Rights Data Collection - Comment Period
