Editing a responsive course section in the new look view returned a missing tool rights error message. This has been corrected. The Schedule Gap Filler was not filling in the open gaps for students with a course when using the Effective Date option. This has been corrected. When manually building sections for two courses that have the combine rule, the combine details were not displaying when hovering over a section in the Scheduling Board. The Combine details only display after saving, closing, and re-opening the trial. This has been corrected. Renumbering course sections in the Scheduling Board was not consistently renumbering them in numeric order. This has been corrected. Students who had dropped a course in the previous year were included in the list of students as having taken that course. This has been corrected so that by default, students who have dropped a course will not be displayed in the filter result set. Making a change on the Scheduling Board and then selecting the Course Planner in the upper right side caused the Scheduling Board to not save the changes made. This has been corrected. The Transcript checkbox on the Course and Course Master editors could not be selected. This has been corrected.
Search	The Advanced Student Search now has an Enrollment option. This option allows users to filter student search results only to include cross-site enrollments, exclude all cross-site enrollments, or view data for all enrollments. The Advanced Course/Selection Search now has a Cross-Site option. This option allows users to filter data to show only cross-site-created courses, exclude cross=site courses, or view all courses.
Security	The <u>User Account</u> tool was updated to automatically assign new user accounts tool rights to My Account tools. These tools allow users to view and access their own data, notifications, and settings. Infinite Campus was unable to properly get an ACME certificate for districts whose new domain name contained their previous domain name (i.e., schoolName.org became campus.schoolName.org). This issue was corrected. Logic was updated to determine the site URL via a record in the preference table if it exists. If not, the existing domain table is used.
Transcripts	 New options have been added to the <u>Transcript Report Setup</u> editor, as follows: Accreditation - this reports the assigned Accreditation Status entered on the School Information editor. Principal - this prints the school principal's name on the Transcript, as entered on the School Information editor. Expected Graduation Year - this prints the student's expected graduation year when a Diploma Date is not entered on their Graduation record.

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
