The Infinite Campus release **Campus.2431** will go into production tomorrow night, **September 11**. Please note, we originally planned to implement **Campus.2435** simultaneously. However, we are postponing this until **September 18** to ensure the [Dual Credit Scholarship Report](#) can be submitted to KHEAA by the **September 15** deadline, before the Roster Batch Edit tool is deprecated.

The original notification combined the release highlights so only Campus.2431 items have been listed in this notification. For state specific items, see the [.2431 Kentucky release notes](#). Review the full manifest of changes in the [Campus.2231 release](#) (Campus ID required).

Assigning tool rights will ensure KDE reports are available to those needing access. Report changes in this release include:

- Cohort years 2025-2030 have been added to the [HS Graduation Requirements Tracking Report](#).
- The LEAD Data Report has been sunset. The [KECS LEAD Extract](#) should be used instead.

Infinite Campus Release Highlights – Campus.2435
Kentucky Specific

Item	Description
Career Readiness	Multiple updates have been made to Error requirements, and the extract editor's default format has been changed to HTML for the Validation Report.
District #880 Name Change	District #880 has been renamed from Residential Youth At-Risk Programs to Kentucky National Guard Youth ChalleNGe Academies, and this change has been made in Infinite Campus.
Kentucky Special Ed Amend Dates Update	Kentucky users can now have an Amendment Start and End Dates on the same day as the plan's original Start and End Dates to comply with KDE standards. This applies to the Individual Education Plan and Private School Plans for Kentucky.
Language List	Dyula has been added, and spelling has been corrected for Kachin: Jingpho in the Language List.
Section Information	The Section Student Detail tool has been added and includes Dual Credit, No Credit, and Repeat fields. This replaces the Roster Batch Edit tool for these data elements. Tool rights will need to be assigned to the appropriate user groups.
State Edition - Ad hoc	The graduationSeal object has been restored in Ad hoc for State Edition.

Campus Digital Repository Off-Premise Hosting Now Available	Customers who have already enabled and are using Campus Digital Repository services now have the option to change their hosting from on-premise to off-premise. Off-premise hosting provides numerous benefits, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • File replication across multiple geographically distant availability zones. • 99.9999999999% durability. • 99.99% availability.

	Switching to off-premise hosting does not change or modify the user experience within Campus, and your existing files are seamlessly migrated without any work or intervention required. If you do not see an option to switch hosting models within the Digital Repository Preferences tool, your district already uses off-premise CDR hosting.
Census – Military Connections	The Military Connections tool now allows users to select all active military members of a student's household and any non-household guardians who are active military.
Census Rules Data Validations Group	Added the ability to run the Census Rules Data Validations Group on a selected school or year
Course Planner - Additional Course Filter Options	<p>The Course Planner Filter for Batch Edit Course Information has been updated to include additional parameters. Users can enter a value for Terms, Schedules, Periods, etc., to return courses meeting those values. They can also select a "Where" value and choose an operator (=, >, etc.) like what is available in Filter Designer.</p> <p>Sections to Build can now be set to a specific value (Text Fill Value) OR to the value from last year's sections, sections needed, or sections placed.</p>
Custom Forms State Edition Publish to Districts Functionality Added	State Edition users can now create an Interactive or Blank Custom Form and publish it for all districts. When districts attach the form to a student, enter data, and lock it, the form automatically syncs back to the state. This applies to all newly created Custom Forms but not existing forms. See the Custom Form Setup article for additional information.
Early Warning - GRAD Score Date Matches Sync Date	<p>The GRAD Score date now reflects the DIS sync date in the State Edition of the Early Warning tool using the label "Last Synced: ##/##/##". This change will not affect the District Edition.</p> <p>A prediction notification was added in the Campus.2423 release to warn users about data depth during the first year and its impact on the validity of a GRAD score. The code was revised as part of this update, and the notification is no longer displayed in the State Edition.</p>
Early Warning Modeling Prediction Annual Updates	The predictive model for the Early Warning tool is retrained and re-evaluated based on the inclusion of an additional year of data. Modeling for the 2023 End Year has been completed, and the predictive model has been fully validated and released. The following features have been removed from the model and are no longer considered in the calculation of Student GRAD scores: Student Race/Ethnicity, Student Gender, and Student Birth Country.
Early Warning User Interface Updates	<p>The Early Warning user interface was updated to enhance user experience:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Converted the lollipop dividers to line dividers in the main visualization graph. • Added a "Calendar End Year" label to the x-axis of the student GRAD Score History graph that displays when 'Annually' is selected in the range droplist. • Updated the CSV file format to export and populate school names in the header row.
Requests and Rosters Updates	<p>Several updates have been made to the Requests and Roster tool, first released in the Campus.2411 (March 2024) Release Pack:</p> <p>On the Roster Builder and Batch Edit Screens:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Request Type dropdown field displays on the row after a course is selected for Batch Edit Student Requests and Batch Edit Course Requests. • The Section Teacher dropdown, the Start Date and End Date fields displays on the row after a course is selected for Batch Edit Student Rosters. • The Start Date, End Date, Repeat, and no Credit fields display on the row when a student is selected for Roster Builder.

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	<p>The Start Date and End Date fields have been added to the Roster Builder section of the side panel. This allows the entry of a student's start date that differs from the term start date or term end date for that section. Or, enter the desired dates in the header and apply that same date to all selected students, along with Repeat and No Credit. Individual assignment of dates and Repeat/No Credit can still be done.</p> <p>On the Student View Filter, the Inactive Students checkbox has been changed to Include Inactive Students, and the Special Education checkbox has been changed to Special Education Only.</p> <p>In Batch Edit Student Rosters in the Student View, a Fill All and Fill Empty option has been added to apply the entered Start Date and End Date to all selected rosters.</p> <p>In Batch Edit Student Requests in the Student view, a Fill All and Fill Empty option has been added to apply the selected Request Type (R, E, or A) to all selected courses.</p> <p>In the Student View and Course View, the teacher's name can now be selected in the Section Roster field.</p> <p>When using Requests & Rosters to update student schedules, the Modified By field on the Walk-In Scheduler was not updating. This has been corrected.</p> <p>The Section and Teacher columns have been combined into one column on the Batch Edit Student Roster panel.</p> <p>When one teacher is used as a filter condition and that teacher only has one section of a course assigned to them, that teacher's name displays in the Section: Teacher column and cannot be modified.</p> <p>Students enrolled in a Cross-Site Enrollment course at the Serving School are now counted in the roster when looking at the course in Requests & Rosters.</p> <p>The Calendar field on the Student View Side Panel now allows the selection of calendars from other schools, not just the current school. This allows filtering based on other school calendars - e.g., selecting a section roster from a middle school from the last school year to add to the high school roster for this school year.</p> <p>A user with Read rights to Requests & Rosters could edit and save changes. This has been corrected.</p> <p>When the roster update fails using Batch Edit Section Rosters and Batch Edit Course Rosters to add students to sections, the request for those students remained as an unsatisfied request. Now, these requests are removed.</p> <p>When building a roster, It is easier to see which students are being removed and added to a section. First, all existing students in that section have a blue checkmark next to their name. When a new student is added, a green plus displays by their name and they are moved to the top of the list alphabetically after the existing students. When an existing student is removed from the roster, the blue check changes to a red x, but the student's name remains in the same place. Once Save is selected, all students in the roster are resorted into</p>

	alphabetical order and display with blue checks; any student who was removed (red x) is no longer listed.
Schedule Wizard and Related Scheduling Tools Removed	Over the last few years, the tools available for building courses, loading requests, planning for staff and necessary courses, and managing rosters have been redesigned with new technology. Those tools are: Scheduling Board, Course Planner, Staff Planner, and Requests & Rosters The following tools have been removed from Campus: Schedule Wizard, Scheduling Build Constraints Wizard, Course Build Constraints, Section Roster Batch Edit, Request Wizard, Roster Copy, and Section Roster Setup.
Signing In to Google Drive	The process for authenticating a Google account has been updated to accommodate recent changes by Google. Integrating Google Drive files functions the same way, but the sign-in process has been simplified. Teachers and students are still prompted to log in to Google Drive when interacting with a file. Additionally, a "Change" button has been added to the teacher's Preferences and the student's Google sign-in screen to allow users to manage which account they're signed into.
Special Ed Documents Amendment Start Date Update	The Amendment Start Date is now displayed in the Document Detail of amended plans. This information can be queried in Ad hoc (Query Wizard > Student > Learner Planning > Learning Plans > learningPlan.amendStartDate). See the Amend Special Ed Documents article for additional information.
Cross-Site Enrollment-Batch Fill Course Masters Setting	A new Cross-Site Course Master Batch Enable tool has been added to the Grading & Standards Cross-Site Mapping options. This new tool allows users to enable Cross-Site Enrollment functionality for all selected Course Masters at once instead of editing each Course Master separately. Users can filter the list of Course Masters by the Course Catalog and/or Course Master Number or Name.
Cross-Site Enrollment - Course, Roster and Enrollment Data Syncing	All Cross-Site Enrollment data related to Courses, Course Sections, Rosters, and Enrollments now syncs with other district data. This daily syncing process ensures that interdistrict Cross-Site Enrollment data is up-to-date.
Cross-Site Enrollment - Grades Tool and Campus Student & Parent	A new Cross-Site Course Master Batch Enable tool has been added to the Grading & Standards Cross-Site Mapping options. This new tool allows users to enable Cross-Site Enrollment functionality for all selected Course Masters at once instead of editing each Course Master separately. Users can filter the list of Course Masters by the Course Catalog and/or Course Master Number or Name.
Cross-Site Enrollment - Home School View, Print Serving School Day Rotation and Period Schedule	Home School users can now print the Calendar Report and the Period Schedules Report for the Serving School. These reports can be printed from the Cross-Site Enrollment setup tool.
Cross-Site Enrollment - Non-Instructional Events Displayed for Home School	For students enrolled in Cross-Site Courses, an indication that the Serving School does not meet on a certain day now displays on the student's Schedule when viewing from the Home School. This can be viewed when looking at the student's schedule in the Day, Week, and Agenda views, available when using the Calendar option to view the student's schedule. That course for the day is highlighted, and when selected to view details in the side panel, additional text displays indicating the course doesn't meet for that day/period.
Cross-Site Enrollment - School Connections	A new tool called School Connections has been added to the Cross-Site Enrollment toolset for use with Intradistrict Cross-Site Enrollment Participation. This tool determines which schools can share/map courses with other schools. Only those schools marked as eligible for service are displayed in the Cross-Site Enrollment Setup tool.

Cross-Site Enrollment Updates	<p>The following updates have been made to Cross-Site Enrollment functionality:</p> <p>Course Master A warning message now displays when attempting to turn off Cross-Site Enrollment on a Course Master when courses have sections with students scheduled into it.</p> <p>Cross-Site Setup When remapping a section at the Home School (for interdistrict CSE), the section version was removed when the schedule placement was changed.</p> <p>Walk-In Scheduler</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When a user attempted to override a course section for students in cross-site courses who had constraints with other students in the course, but the user didn't have tool rights to Can Overload Sections or Can Override Strict Student Constraints, the alert text did not display for the cross-site course. It does now. • The Lock/Unlock buttons on the student's schedule were previously hidden from the Serving School side, but users could still perform these actions by clicking on the icons in the course grid. This action has been removed. Serving School users cannot lock or unlock a Cross-Site student's schedule. • The Walk-In Scheduler Modified By Date and Time for Cross-Site rosters has been modified to the following: * At the Initiating School, the name of the person who made the update. * At the Receiving School, the words "Cross-Site Action" display. The time shows when the roster was added or the change was processed. • When dropping a course in the last term at an intradistrict Cross-Site school, the course drop date was displayed on all terms instead of just the last term. This has been corrected. <p>The following functionality has been added to Cross-Site Enrollment tools and processes:</p> <p>Cross-Site Setup</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For Interdistrict Cross-Site, when a Serving School modifies a course section and re-offers it, the section at the home school will now display with an Invalid Mapping label. The process for correcting this is the same process used for intradistrict. • Changes made to the Cross-Site Instructional Settings field now makes any sections mapped to external schools invalid for all CSE participation options. Fields are not editable when Cross-Site is enabled for the section. <p>Walk-In Scheduling The text that displays when a Cross-Site enrollment is being created has been updated to note that a new enrollment at the serving school is being created when the student does not already have an enrollment there.</p>

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
