Good morning,

Please see the message below from Josh Whitlow.

This is just a quick reminder about “No Show” students. An enrollment status of "No Show" indicates a student was enrolled in a district at the end of the prior year (2023-2024 school year), but did not show up for the current school year (2024-2025 school year). These records are used to determine whether a student is considered a drop-out for the state, and is also used for federal reporting. These records are also used by the district to track the student’s last known address.

Districts should review guidelines regarding different scenarios, making sure students are marked correctly. The [No Show](#) Data Standard has been updated and linked to this email.
