Infinite Campus Release Highlights – Campus.2443 Kentucky Specific

Section Student Detail	With the release of Campus.2435 (August 2024), the Roster Batch Edit tool was removed.
	Existing data from the Roster Batch Edit tool was converted to the Section Student Detail tool
	for Kentucky. Section Student Detail records are converted when the student has values in
	the Dual Credit, Repeat Course, or No Credit fields.
SSN Diet	People's Social Security Numbers no longer sync to the state of Kentucky.
Testing Roster Extract	Previously, the <u>Testing Roster Extract</u> only considered the student's latest Enrollment record
	in the calendar to determine the report population. The report was updated to show all
	students with Enrollment records during the extract dates.
Special Ed Evaluation	An issue was fixed in which the List Current Disability Area(s) field on the RR-Review of
	Existing Data editor of the Kentucky Evaluation did not populate correctly when Specific

Item	Description
Campus Instruction	Previously, an error occurred in the Teaching Center if the Period Schedule included periods with a Sequence of 63 or higher. The <u>Teaching Center</u> has been updated so that if a period has a Sequence of 63 or higher, the Teaching Center loads properly but there is no indicator of whether section attendance has been taken. For these sections, an indication of attendance taken also does not display in the <u>Attendance tool</u> .
	Previously, some users encountered an error in <u>Reports</u> if they were not already in the context of a Term/Section. This has been corrected.
Combine Person	Previously, if a user with a user account created a Messenger template and their record was later discovered to be a duplicate, their record could not be merged with the original record using the Combine Person tool if the original record did not have a user account. This has been corrected.
Scheduling	An error message displayed when selecting a course on the student's <u>Schedule</u> in the Calendar or Term views and choosing Grades from the side panel. This has been corrected.
Assessment	The <u>Assessment Center's Import Data</u> functionality (step 5) did not display multiple sets of child records when more than one row existed for a student. This issue has been resolved. When a source file has multiple rows of score data for a single student, and each row has a different score date, all score data for all tests (parent, child, etc.) is imported and displayed for each test score date.
