Reminder – Infinite Campus release Campus.2451 will go into production tonight night (1/8). Details for the release were provided in the previous notification below.

The release notes included information about Interdistrict Cross-Site Enrollment (CSE) but this functionality is not yet available in Kentucky. KDE is working with Campus for CSE to send the home school more course information to meet state reporting requirements.

The HS Graduation Requirements Tracking report is being sunset with this release. Due to the diverse and personalized paths students may take to meet high school graduation requirements, this tool is limited in accurately determining student progress. Consequently, it cannot fully and accurately verify the completion of state and local graduation requirements necessary for awarding a high school diploma in accordance with 704 KAR 3:305.
