Infinite Campus Release Highlights – Campus.2447 Kentucky Specific

Item	Description
Attendance	 An issue was fixed where users experienced an error when entering check-out times for student attendance. This error only occurred when a student was in two cross-site sections mapped to the same period at the home school and offered during the same period at the serving school. An issue with the Attendance tool was fixed after deleting a behavior resolution or role for Kentucky.
Behavior	A checkbox was added for "Medical Intervention Provided" that is activated if a behavior event of Tobacco Use or Drug Use is selected. The checkbox will not be a required field.
Course Information	 A new value, 21 Offsite Workplace, was added to the Instructional Setting dropdown on the Kentucky Course Information tool. A new value, 21 Work-Based Learning, was added to the Teaching Method dropdown on the Kentucky Course Information tool. The Section Student Detail was previously added (August 2024, Campus.2435) for Kentucky. With this update, Section Student Detail data now syncs to the state in the database.
Enrollments	We Lead CS was added to the list of districts available in the Enrollments tool Resident District dropdown for Kentucky.
Supplemental School Year Program	The Supplemental School Year Program was rewritten in the New Look of Campus.

Core Product – Bub Fixes

Item	Description
Custom	In the New Look of Campus, when selecting a student and a URL Link/URL Editor using 'Pass User Session' functionality, the contextIDType passed as null instead of studentID. This issue was corrected.
	Custom URLs passing parameters using the 'Pass User Session' option passed a blank contextID in the New Look of Campus. Any reports depending on contextID gave users a missing parameter error upon generation. This issue was corrected.
Cross-Site Enrollment	When a primary enrollment at the home school is deleted before dropping the course at the serving school, the student could not be removed from the Cross-Site Enrollment course. This has been corrected. Deleting the enrollment at the home school also deletes the partial enrollment and ends the roster record at the Serving School. To delete the roster record at the Serving School, use the Roster Update side panel in the Walk-In Schedule.

Item	Description
Grades Reporting	Previously, the incorrect grade displayed in the Grades tool if the view was filtered to a single term and the student had transferred between sections in the same course. This has been corrected.
Insights	The Insights Behavior Suspensions by Student and Insights Behavior Suspensions by Event Type reports would, if no suspensions were present, allow for detention data to be included in the report. This has been corrected.
Student Information	An issue with the <u>Summary tool</u> in New Look that caused locker, state race and ethnicity, homeroom, and custom fields to not populate correctly when moving from one student to another has been resolved.
