### **School Report Card Public Release Wednesday, Oct. 14**

The early release (embargo) period for the School Report Card (SRC) began for districts, Friday, Oct. 9 and the media, today, Oct. 12. The embargo period provides districts time to see all final School Report Cards and the media time to work on stories to coincide with the public release date. Instructions on how to access the preview site were shared with DACs and SRCCs on Friday along with the press release that was shared with the media.

**All data is embargoed until Oct. 14;** however, it may be discussed with media during this period to prepare for a local press release. As a reminder, during an embargo, district and school staff may discuss the data results with teachers, local board members or school-based decision making council members; however, data cannot be shared in public meetings or by the media. District and school leadership may talk with media who agree to abide by the embargo.
