## School Report Card (SRC) Monitor Tools Available

The Review Flags Report and the Monitor Approval Progress tools are now available to districts.

Unfortunately, AnLar was unable to restore previously approved domains for all schools and districts. If you see domains you previously approved that aren't now, please approve again. KDE only monitors district approvals; the requirement for school-level approvals continues to be a district choice.

Superintendent messages also were restored by AnLar for all but two districts. Content for those two districts is available, but the applicable district is not referenced in the content. Reach out to [KDE Data Services](#) if your district's message is still missing. We appreciate your patience as we work through issues.

KDE responses and updates to flag statuses are available in the Approval --Review Flags Report. Review both raised and lowered flags and associated comments within this tool. Unfortunately, some of the KDE responses have disappeared, but we are attempting to get all flags responded to as quickly as possible. If you have follow-up questions, contact the KDE responder for additional help.

Additional charts and trend views are now available for district review in the Preview tool. Use the options on the right side to switch between options (i.e., comparison, trend and table) available. The suppression toggle is being enabled today, so schools and districts can verify unsuppressed data and also see how suppressed data will look in the public view. Assessment and Accountability data will only be available as a suppressed view when it becomes available.

We've had a few reports of collection items not mapping correctly and Monitor Collection Progress Report not reflecting correctly. Continue to report any issues to the [AnLar help desk](#).

As a reminder, the due date for all collection data remains is tomorrow, Nov. 8; however, the district preview and approval period was extended to Friday, Nov. 22.

Career and technical education (CTE) data is available in the [School Report Card \(SRC\) Suite Collection and Approval Portal](#) for school and district review and approval. Career Pathways data is now final and has been updated.

School Accountability and Academic Performance data and prior year (2021-2022 and 2022-2023) data is expected to be available mid-November. Since this data is already final, it does not require approval, but districts should take the opportunity to review prior to public release.

The [current School Report Card Suite dashboard tool](#) will sunset in December. There is limited time to compare data previously reported in the dashboard view to the new School Report Card dashboard data.

Outstanding issues with the views, functionality of the system or questions about the training or Quick Reference Guides on the [SRC Resource webpage](#) should be reported to the [AnLar help desk](#). Known issues listed below do not need to be reported or flagged.

- Teacher Working Conditions data is being updated and will be available soon.
- Teacher Certification numbers are not displayed correctly.
- Aggregation of ineffective teachers' equity calculations to district level are not available. The calculation will aggregate data entered by schools in the collection tool to calculate district values.
- Data tables for Students with Disabilities are not showing in the Overview Student Subgroup Domain.
