ESEA section 2103(b)(3)(D) permits LEAs to use Title II, Part A funds to reduce class size as one strategy to attract and retain effective educators in high-need schools. This requirement presumes that LEAs will not use Title II, Part A funds to hire or pay teachers for the purpose of class size reduction unless the LEA has previously determined the teachers to be effective. Although LEAs conduct their own measures of effectiveness based on [KRS 156.557](#) and subsequent local district policy, a baseline definition of an effective teacher is a teacher who holds a valid teaching certificate in the content and grade level to which he or she is assigned.
