

# Kentucky Crop Timeline

## Tobacco

| Time of Year        | Activities   |
|---------------------|--|
| March – April       | Preparing soil, sowing seeds in tobacco beds, tobacco green houses, preparing      |
|                     | floating beds for plants   |
| May – July          | Planting tobacco, pulling tobacco plants, plugging tobacco plants, setting tobacco |
| June – August       | Chopping tobacco, hoeing tobacco, irrigating tobacco                               |
| July – August       | Topping tobacco, spraying/oiling tobacco, hand pollinating tobacco                 |
| August – December   | Topping, cutting tobacco, housing tobacco  |
| November – February | Stripping tobacco, bulking tobacco, cleaning barns                                 |

# Vegetables

| Time of Year   | Activities   |
|----------------|--|
| May – June     | Planting: cabbage, corn, cucumbers, lettuce, peppers, pumpkins, squash, tomatoes |
| July – August  | Planting: broccoli   |
| June - October | Harvesting/picking: all the above  |

# Hay

| Time of Year    | Activities              |
|-----------------|-------------------------|
| May – September | Baling hay, hauling hay |

## **Soybeans**

| Time of Year         | Activities                                      |
|----------------------|---|
| April – May          | Cultivating soil for soybeans                   |
| May – June           | Planting soybeans                               |
| June – August        | Applying insect control, applying weed control  |
| September – November | Harvesting soybeans, hauling soybeans to market |

## Strawberries

| Time of Year  | Activities  |
|---------------|---|
| March – April | Preparing soil, fertilizing, and planting             |
| May – July    | De-blooming, harvesting, weeding, spraying            |
| August        | Harvesting, weeding, fertilizing and soil preparation |
| December      | Mulching  |

# **Blueberries/Blackberries**

| Time of Year       | Activities                                    |
|--------------------|---|
| February           | Pruning established vines                     |
| March – May        | Planting first-time crop or replacement vines |
| May – June         | Harvesting/picking                            |
| October - November | Planting first time crop or replacement vines |

#### **Seasonal**

Growing season for plants and demand of plants

- Flowers (e.g., roses, poinsettias, ferns)
- Plants and herbs (e.g., garlic, basil, oregano, lavender)
- Sod farms (prepare, maintain, cut, stacking, rolling)
- Christmas tree farms (cultivating, cutting and stacking)
- Harvesting wheat
- Self-sustaining seasonal nurseries
- Mowing, clipping, dragging pastures
- Hemp production (hoeing hemp, planting hemp, etc. only if in a Kentucky registered/licensed farm)

#### **Temporary**

List contains most common, but not all, qualifying temporary work

- Chicken or Beef Processing (handling of raw material)
- Caring for, catching, deboning, hanging chickens
- Milking cows
- Feeding chickens, cattle, pigs, hogs
- Gathering/collecting eggs
- Fencing work (additional information may be required)
- Barn or fence repairs
- Year-round nurseries
- Mending fences, building fences, cleaning fence rows, installing fences, fixing fences
- Repairing tobacco barns
- Cutting trees at a sawmill, debarking lumber
