3a. Participation rate for children with IEPs.

Math and Reading/Languages Grades- 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, HS **with and without accommodations by State/District and Schools.**

1. Go to the [2023-24 Assessment Participation for Students with Disabilities](#) worksheet.
2. Click on the corresponding tab to view the Math data or Reading data.
3. To select a specific district, click in the column labeled “DistrictName” (column A) and filter for the required district.
4. To select a specific school, click in the column labeled “SchoolName” (column B) and filter for the required school.
5. To select the state totals, click in the column labeled “DistrictName” (column A) and filter for “--State Total---”.
6. To select a specific grade, click in the column labeled “Grade” (column C) and filter for the required grade.

3b. Proficiency rate for children with IEPs against grade level academic achievement standards.

Math and Reading/Languages Grades- 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, HS by State/District and Schools.

1. Click [Kentucky Summative Assessment Performance](#) on [Kentucky's Academic Performance Datasets page for 2024-2025](#) (select 2024-2025 in the School Year dropdown at the top). An Excel spreadsheet that contains all assessment performance data, including data for students with disabilities, will be downloaded.
2. In the spreadsheet, click on the “Sort & Filter” icon in the “Editing” section of the menu on the Home tab. Then click “Filter”.
3. Use the filtered spreadsheet generated from the instructions above from the school report card.
4. To select a certain subject, click on the column titled “Subject” (column O), and filter for the requested subject.
5. To select a certain school, click on the column titled “School Name” (column G), and filter for the requested school.
6. To select a certain district, click on the column titled “District Name” (column E) and filter for the requested district.
7. To find district totals, select the district as described in the step above and filter the column titled “School Number” (column F) for “(Blanks)”.
8. To select state data, click on the column titled “District Name” (column E), and filter for “All Districts”.
9. To select a specific grade, click on the column titled “Grade” (column N), and filter for the requested grade. Kentucky assesses grades 3 through 8 as well as grades 10 and 11.
10. To select all students with IEPs, click on the column title “Demographic” (column P), and filter for “Students with Disabilities (IEP)”.
11. To select all students with IEPs on the regular assessment, click on the column title “Demographic” (column P), and filter for “Students with Disabilities/IEP Regular Assessment”.
12. To select all students with IEPs with accommodations, click on the column title “Demographic” (column P), and filter for “Students with Disabilities/IEP with Accommodations”.

3. In the spreadsheet, click on the “Sort & Filter” icon in the “Editing” section of the menu on the Home tab. Then click “Filter”.
4. To select all students who participated in the alternate assessment, click on the column title “Demographic” (column P), and filter for “Alternate Assessment”.
5. To select a certain subject, click on the column titled “Subject” (column O), and filter for the requested subject.
6. To select a certain school, click on the column titled “School Name” (column G), and filter for the requested school.
7. To select a certain district, click on the column titled “District Name” (column E) and filter for the requested district.
8. To find district totals, select the district as described in the step above and filter the column titled “School Number” (column F) for “(Blanks)”.
9. To select state data, click on the column titled “District Name” (column E), and filter for “All Districts”.
