Subject: Enhancements to Maintenance of Certification (MOC) Instructions

Our records show you are eligible to pursue Maintenance of Certification (MOC) during the upcoming 2022-23 assessment cycle. Before you begin your journey, we want to let you know that the MOC instructions have recently been updated for ease of use and to address frequently asked questions (FAQs). Note that the basic MOC requirements have not changed.

We've provided a high-level overview of updates and enhancements below; please be sure you are using the most up-to-date version (copyrighted 2022), located online on the [MOC Candidate Resources](#) page of the National Board website.

- Language has been added to the following sections to address FAQs: “Prepare”, “Develop”, “Assessing and Understanding Your Results”, and “Retake Guidelines”. Within the “Develop” section language was added to Component 1: Specifications for Written Materials and Evidence and Component 2 Specifications.
- Critical requirements and considerations for submission have been highlighted – refer to bold text and gray boxes throughout the instructions.
- Additional subheadings have been added to identify commonly overlooked requirements (e.g., anonymity guidelines, use of digital images, etc.)
- Additional hyperlinks have been added to the Table of Contents and throughout the document for quick access to information and downloadable tables and forms.
- Addition of “Getting Started with Identifying Your PGEs” section to more clearly provide candidates with considerations as they begin the process of identifying and selecting PGEs
