Notes on SpEd_Evaluation_Detail (2)

 It is NOT a concern if the Eligibility Determination Date column says "Missing Eligibility Date" if an Initial Evaluation/Eligibility Determination document dated after the Date of Consent for Initial Evaluation has NOT been completed and locked.

More Notes

- If a student has left the district, the column labeled "Enrollment End Date" will have a date. Filter these students out.
- Preschool days will not be accurate. Districts will need to calculate those.



More Notes (2)

- Include students from the previous year who were not in the district long enough to have eligibility determined.
- Also include students from this school year who were in the district long enough after the Date of Consent for Initial Evaluation to have eligibility determined.

- This compliance indicator measures the percentage of children:
 - Referred by Part C prior to age 3
 - Who are found eligible for Part B
 - Who have an Individualized Education Program (IEP) developed and implemented by their 3rd birthday

Measurement for Indicator 12

- a. Number of children who have been served in Part C and referred to Part B for Part B eligibility determination.
- b. Number of those referred determined to be NOT eligible and whose eligibility was determined prior to their 3rd birthdays.



Measurement for Indicator 12 (2)

- c. Number of those found eligible who have an IEP developed and implemented by their 3rd birthdays.
- d. Number of children for whom parent refusal to provide consent caused delays in evaluation or initial services or to whom exceptions under 34 CFR §300.301(d) applied.

New Method of Data Collection

Old Method:

- Google Form
- Complicated
- State Student Identifiers (SSIDs) requested AFTER survey

New Method:

- <u>Survey</u>
- SSIDs must be READILY available in case they are requested

Personnel Full Time Equivalency (FTE)

Report by FTE

- Percentage of time each person works specifically with students with disabilities receiving special education and related services
- Rounded to the nearest hundredth of a decimal place
- If a teacher works with both students with disabilities and students without disabilities, report only the portion of the FTE spent with students with disabilities

Personnel – FTE Example

- Teacher 1: Works with students with disabilities for three hours out of a six-hour day
 - Report 0.50 FTE
- Teacher 2: Works with students with disabilities for four hours out of a six-hour day
 - Report 0.67 FTE
- District employs both Teacher 1 and Teacher 2 above

Behavior Data Collection

- Definition of "In School Removal" (INSR) expanded to include removals during non-instructional time, i.e., lunch, recess, study periods
- In District Removal (INDR): "In District Removal" should be mapped to local resolutions involving a student's removal to a location other than the school where the student regularly attends, such as an offsite alternative program or another school within the district.

How is a Student Included?

- Removal length must be greater than zero
- ResolutionStateCode must be one of the codes listed in the previous slide
- Demographic data for a student is obtained from the child count report
- If the student was not on the child count report, use the demographic information from the final record in Safe Schools.

How are Removals Calculated?

- Students must be cumulatively removed a total of a half day or more.
- Every removal one hundredth of a day or longer (in-school, outof-school or IAES) is a removal.
- For removals involving unduplicated counts of students, calculate the sum of lengths of all removals in each category separately. A student may be included in both counts.
- For total removals, calculate the number of resolutions involving either in-school or out-of-school removals.

Things to Look for in Safe Schools

- Long restraints or suspensions
- Overlapping or duplicate resolutions
- Unreasonable data (multi-day restraints, extremely long suspensions, etc.)

Behavior Reporting

- All resolutions of **INSR** and **INDR** will be included in the Safe Schools Report.
- School Report Card will aggregate the records for these two codes and report them together.
- **INSR** or **INDR** resolutions with a length of less than a half day will not be included in the School Report Card.

Interim Alternative Educational Setting (IAES)

- In the Safe Schools Report, check all students with a resolution of IAES1 or IAES2.
- Be sure all students with these resolutions have IEPs.
- Be sure all students with these resolutions have appropriate reasons for the *Interim Alternative Educational* Settings (drugs, weapons, or serious bodily injury).

Exit Report Validation

- To be included on the report:
 - The student must be age 14 21 on the Dec. 1 prior to exiting
 - The student must have been enrolled on or before Oct. 1
 - Student must one of the following during the current school year:

- Special Ed Exit Status
- Special Ed Exit Date
- KDE Determined SPED Exit Status
- KDE Determined SPED Exit Date



KY Special Education in Infinite Campus "Elements"

From "4.0" to "Elements"

- Infinite Campus is updating the look and feel of the user interface.
 - IC refers to their current interface as 4.0 and the new interface as Elements.
- Members from the Special Education Advisory Group for Infinite Campus (SEAGIC) and The Office of Special Education and Early Learning (OSEEL) met with IC to discuss, and vet proposed changes to Kentucky's special education documents within IC.

Kentucky Department of EDUCATION

What IS NOT changing?

- No changes to most printed documents.
 - There will be minor changes/corrections made to the Learner Characteristics Inventory section of the KY IEP.

• No data entry validations are being removed.



What **IS** changing?

- There will be a new look to the data entry screens (editors).
- "Yes/No" checkboxes will be changed to dropdown menus.

- Each document will have a "landing page."
- There will be "status pills" for all editors:
 - Not started (black)
 In progress (blue)
 Completed (green)
 Not needed (green)

What **IS** changing? (2)

- All editors must be marked as either "completed" or "not needed" before a document can be locked.
- Buttons will be moved to the bottom of the screen.
- Required fields will be labeled with an asterisk instead of red text.

Multiple Users

- Only one user at a time can actively work on an editor.
- A person with a padlock icon i displays in the Editors side panel, Editor Home and List Screen of list editors indicating which editors currently have users working on them. Hovering over the icon displays the name of the user who has checked out the editor, including the current user (you).

Multiple Users (2)

• Editors that are currently being edited are read only for all other users. The name of the person working on the editor displays in the header. Once the editing user navigates away from an editor, that editor becomes available to work on.
