- KBE completed two reads and approved the changes to 704 KAR 3:370.
- Amendments to 704 KAR 3:370 filed with the Legislative Research Commission on December 13, 2019. Published in the Administrative Register on January 1, 2020.
- A public hearing February 24, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. in the State Board Room.
 - Written notification within 5 working days prior
 - If notification is not received, hearing may be canceled.

- Written Comments shall be accepted through February 29, 2020.
- If no comments are received, the amendments are likely to be effective by June 30, 2020.
- If comments are received the effective date may be extended to August 4, 2020.
